NO CONDEMNATION, Part 23

*Therefore the believer is freed "by the body of
Christ" that is, His death. Christ redeemed the
believer from the law

- —by being a curse (Galatians 3:10, 13)
- —by His blood (Ephesians 1:7; 2:13)
- —by His flesh (Ephesians 2:15)
- —by the cross (Ephesians 2:16)
- —by the body of His flesh (Colossians 1:22)

Because of all this, the believer is free from the law (1 Peter 2:24; 3:18)

Note: The glorious purpose for the believer's death to the law—so he can be united to Christ, the living and risen Lord (Romans 7:14; 1 Corinthians 6:15; Ephesians 5:30)
